

Accessing the Great Courses sets on U3A Bendigo's network server: *ben*

Four Great Courses online lecture sets were purchased in 2017:

<i>Title</i>	<i>Type and Duration</i>	<i>File Formats</i>
Everyday Engineering	36 x 30 min video lectures	M4V and WMV
How Music and Mathematics Relate	12 x 45 min video lectures	M4V and WMV
Myth in Human History	36 x 30 min audio lecture	M4B and MP3
Turning Points in Middle Eastern History	36 x 30 min video lectures	M4V and WMV

They are stored on U3A Bendigo's network server *ben*. A PDF copy of the Course Booklet is stored with each file set. The lectures can be accessed from U3A's Large Screen TVs, U3A Bendigo Presentation PCs and members' devices that are joined to the WiFi network at St Mary's. Some possible access options are:

From the Large Screen TVs in Rooms 1 and 2

1. Press the *Home* button on the TV remote.
2. Navigate to the *Photo and Video* tab and press Enter.
3. Select All > Select Folders > Select *Great Courses on ben* and press Enter.
4. Select the required lecture folder.

Note: The LG TVs can play M4V and WMV video format lectures and MP3 audio format lectures.

From U3A Presentation PCs

There is a shortcut to the Great Courses volume on Ben on the Desktop of the U3A Bendigo presentation PCs. Ask a member of the Technology Support Team for assistance.

From Member Devices

The courses can also be accessed from Windows and Mac PCs, iPads and Android tablets and Android Phones and iPhones that are attached to the LAN at St Mary's. Ask a member of the Technology Support Team for assistance.
